with the socks right on top of each other...and the heel pointing up...start at the toe and roll... just keep rolling...

still rolling...make sure to keep the bottom edge as straight at you can...

finished rolling...place rubber band around...sorta near the bottom...i know i had 2 rubber bands in the supply pics....but i only used one...
